

## Safe Transportation

### Transportation from Port of Entry

Students are informed that direct, uninterrupted travel must be arranged from their port of entry to Canada to their quarantine. Students are advised to arrange for pick-up from their port of entry by friends, family, or private transport. Private transport may include rental car, personal vehicle, quarantine facility shuttle service or taxi/limousine service. [Public transportation](#) is not deemed an appropriate means of travel by CBSA to the place of quarantine. Students and their co-arriving family must not take public transportation (e.g. bus, taxi, subway, coach bus, Uber, Lyft when leaving the airport.)

If required, private transportation from the airport to quarantine accommodations will be pre-arranged by **CMU College** on the student's behalf to take the student and co-arriving family member(s) to their quarantine accommodations so that they shall start their Quarantine Plan. Transportation from the airport to the student's quarantine accommodations organized by CMU College will be provided by [Red Car Service](#) or [Pearson Limo Company](#). (*These services meet public health, IRCC, and CBSA safety guidelines for physical distancing*).

While in transit to the port of departure in their home country, in airports and during flights, and on arrival, students will be expected to follow all recommended personal hygiene and physical distancing guidelines as per Public Health Ontario, including:

- Wearing a mask and gloves
- Washing/sanitizing hands frequently
- Observing appropriate physical distancing

Students and their co-arriving family **MUST** proceed directly and immediately to their quarantine accommodations. No planned or unplanned stops during travel to the quarantine site are permitted. Failure to follow the Quarantine Plan will result in penalties that include fines, imprisonment and possible expulsion from CMU College.

Students are asked to submit their transportation plan prior to arrival, and they are required to meet the cost of transportation from their port of entry to their place of quarantine.

### Transportation to and from a COVID-19 Testing Centre

The Ontario government requires all newly arrived international students to be tested for COVID-19 towards the end of their 14-day quarantine period. This is mandatory even if the student had tested negative for the virus before travelling to Canada, and it is required for co-arriving family members if the student is travelling with immediate family members. CMU will coordinate arrangements with the student's quarantine site provider or directly with the student for COVID-19 testing at or near the student's quarantine site once their arrival is confirmed. Safe transportation to the testing location from student's quarantine location and back will be organized by CMU College and provided by [Red Car Service](#) or [Pearson Limo Company](#). (*These services meet public health, IRCC, and CBSA safety guidelines for physical distancing*).

CMU staff or designated volunteers will follow up to check that the test has been conducted with a negative result before the student and co-arriving family members end their quarantine period. Students will be counselled that they must remain in quarantine until a negative test result is received, even if this means prolonging the quarantine period past Day 14.
